1 Borealis

New Orleans designer Bradley L Bowers looked to the northern lights to develop this dynamic gradient pattern for Wolf-Gordon. Fitted with an osnaburg fabric backing and featuring a substrate width of 1.37 metres, the vinyl wallcovering is offered in four vibrant colourways. *wolfgordon.com*

2 Forest

Currently the star of a solo exhibition at NYC's Guggenheim, American artist Nick Cave based this KnollTextiles pattern on his 2011 work *Architectural Forest*, which joins together patterned strands of bamboo. Just like that installation, the polyester wallcovering is a burst of psychedelic joy. *knolltextiles.com*

3 Waterworld

Chemetal's textured, embossed design is available on over 35 of its aluminum offerings, in finishes ranging from polished brass to satin silver. Ready to fasten to substrates via contact adhesive or red glue, its sheets are offered in two sizes: 1.22 by 2.44 metres and 1.22 by 3.05 metres. *chemetal.com*

4 Hologram

Bodaq Interior Film's collection of metal-look vinyl films brings a futuristic, sci-fi feel to interiors. Its high-gloss Hologram range includes four colourways: Mermaid Green (shown), Aurora (which skews pink), Ice Queen (purple) and Northern Lights (a subtle grey).
